

- part of "research support" networkexamples: IT unit, library, HPC, . . .


Module 6: RSE Infrastructure Provisioning

- link between central IT unit and research (avoid duplication)



• DFG "Guidelines for Safeguarding Good Research Practice": require long-term preservation in an adequate way; for software requires active maintenance


