A working group with members from all Helmholtz centers has been working on defining this new indicator and the Helmholtz general assembly has approved their suggestion in its fall meeting of 2024. The indicator is based on a maturity model looking at various aspects of a research software publication, thus also providing value to the authors of the software and research software researchers as it makes multiple aspects of research software as a scientific publication itself visible.

The Helmholtz Research Software Directory (Helmholtz RSD) has been established as a central marketplace for research software within the Helmholtz Association, fostering visibility and reuse of software assets. The talk will provide an overview of the current status of the Helmholtz RSD, highlight key achievements from the past year. We will introduce the newly developed License Consultation service, that is designed to establish a framework for tailored license consultation processes at individual Helmholtz Centres. Additionally, we will present advancements in the federation of individual RSD instances. In this context, we will provide insight into the associated project nfdi.software and its role in the RSD ecosystem. Lastly, we will outline the contribution of the RSD to the Helmholtz Software Indicator, indicating potential use cases that will aid software developers in assessing their research software for the upcoming PoF period.
