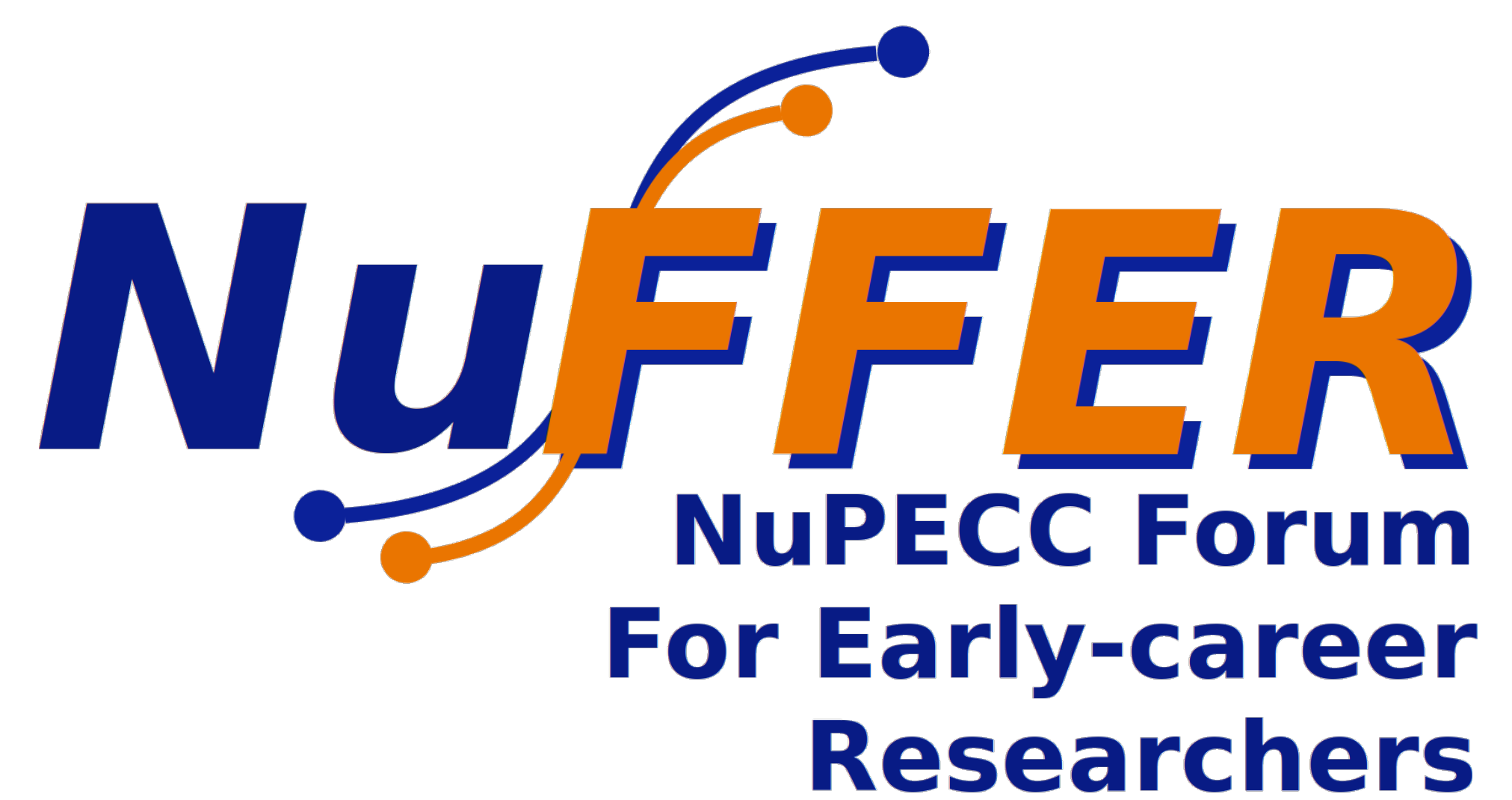


# NuPECC Forum For Early-career Researchers

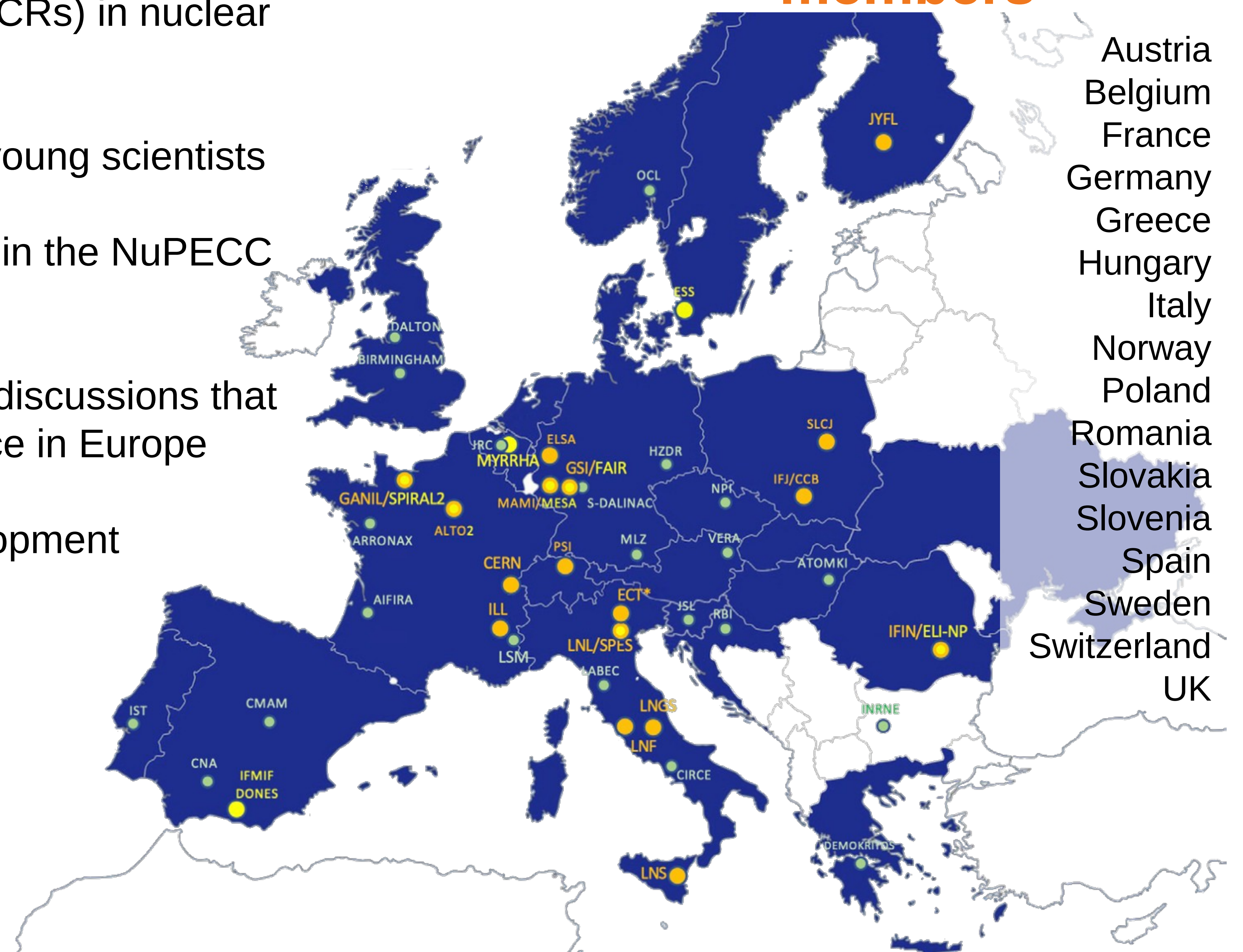


NuFFER is an initiative to connect, support, and promote the work of emerging scientists in nuclear physics across Europe

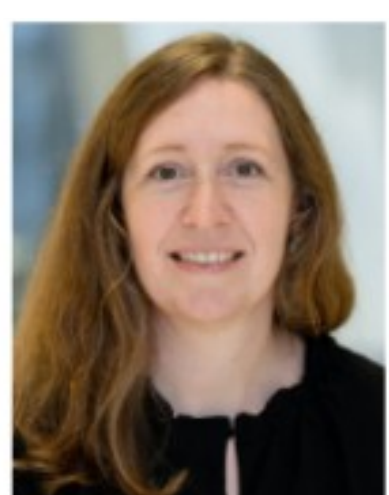

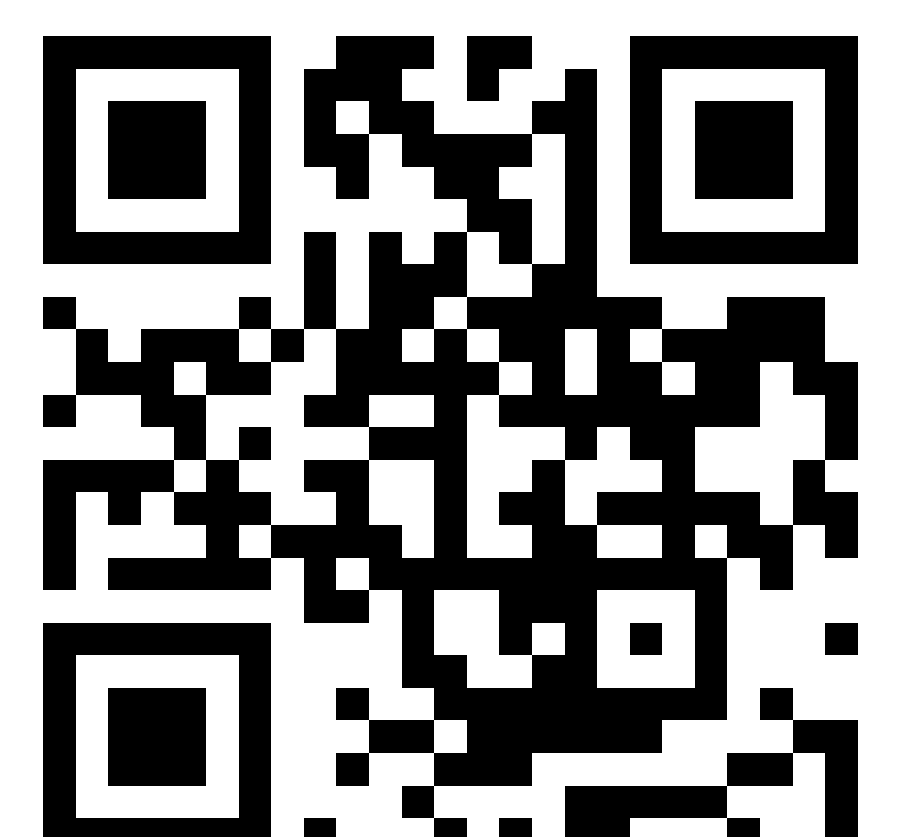
