What did you like?

- I like the graphics, and also the content of presentations.
- Nice gather town map
- the gather town map was very nice, well done! it worked very well and it was perfect to present the posters digitally, very professional!!!

What didn't you like?

- Carpet in lecture hall
- The scheduling was not ideal, especially the morning sessions. I think there was a PDF available, but I didn't have time to read it. I think it would be nice to have more time to read it.
- I would prefer if the conference started punctually each day
- It would be great if the poster sessions were on a different floor or in a different room. It was a bit noisy and there were a lot of people in the room.
- Less dense scheduling of the presentations/talks
- The town is nice and all, but we had almost no occasions to explore and use e.g. the lobby
- Not enough time at the beginning of the conference to find the way through the gather.
- the and other rooms could have been enriched with more parallel workshops & sessions

What could be improved?

- Consider time it takes for presenters to start and time for questions in the time table
- Inverse the lecture hall to poster room and vice versa. Room 1 should be on the left, room 2 on the right
- If presenters had more feedback or time to interact with the audience, it would be great. I think it would be good to have a conference with an interactive element.
- split posters into rooms based on the day they are presented, or put them all in one room
- longer lunch breaks
- Scheduling could have been better, leaving some time for the discussion
- Minor technical issue: clicking links on some of the posters closed gather town. Maybe authors could be instructed how to include links which always open in a new window or tab
- There's always the possibility to "right click" and select "Open in new window" or "Open in new tab".
- there could be some sort of 'guided tour' through the poster halls because there haven't been many people and presentations of the posters... people have become shy on online gatherings ;)
- For me it was not possible to open the posters. I always needed to download them. I couldn't change the settings. The settings are managed by your organisation.
