


Structure of the ORCID Germany Consortium


ORCID DE

- ORCID DE is a project which aims to promote the widespread implementation of ORCID at universities and other research organizations.
- Funded by the German Research Foundation (DFG):
 - First project phase (2016 – 2019, application)
 - Second project phase (2020 – 2022, application)
- Goal of ORCID DE 2: Support of the implementation of ORCID in Germany in a sustainable way through an overarching approach
- The focus is equally on organizational, technical and legal issues.
- In addition to the creation of a central contact point for research organizations (<https://www.orcid-de.org>), the project focuses on the networking and dissemination of ORCID IDs in the field of digital information infrastructures.
