

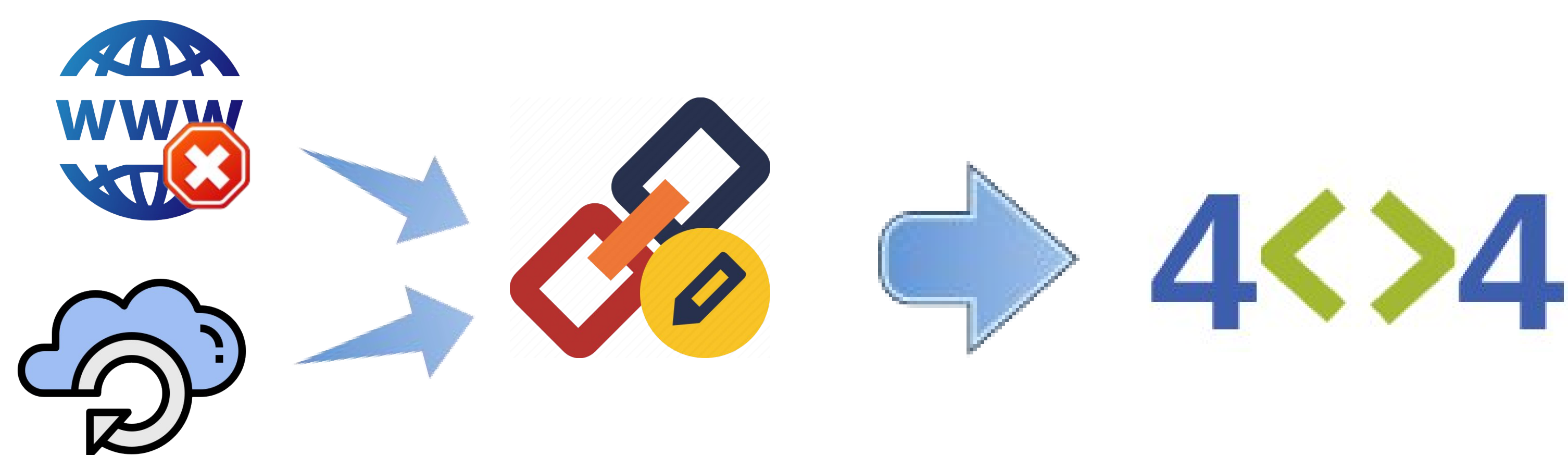
PIDA - Persistent Identifiers for Digital Assets

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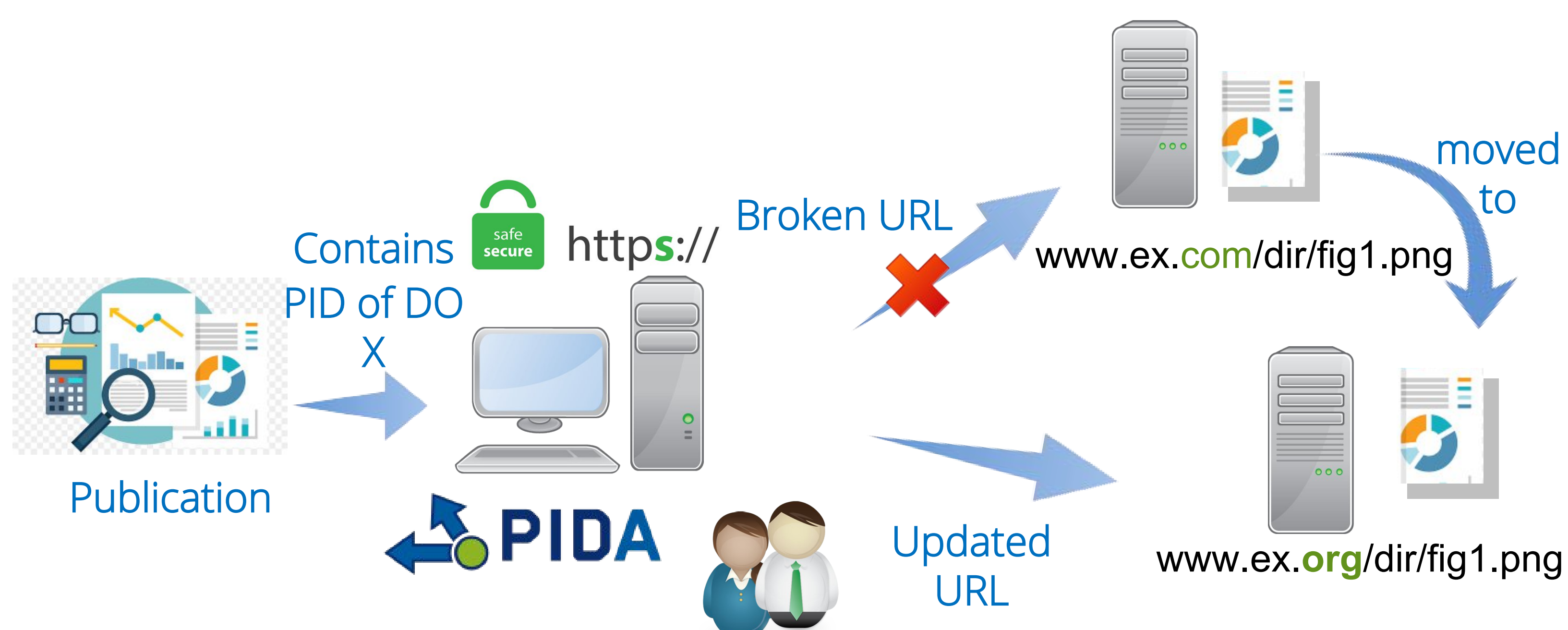
1. Problem: Link Rot

- links to resources become no longer available.



2. Solution: Use Persistent Identifiers

- A PID is a long-lasting reference to digital objects.
- PID remains constant regardless of changes to the location it re-directs to.
